Each year, on 25 December, we celebrate the arrival of the King. Which King? The King of the Jews. That was the charge sheet nailed to the cross above the head of Jesus. On 25 December, followers of Jesus celebrate the arrival of the man born King of the Jews. I think it's amazing, don't you, that the whole world it seems, hates the Jews.

Even when a group of terrorists kills as many as 1200 of Israel's citizens, the world criticises Israel for defending herself. The world just hates the Jews. 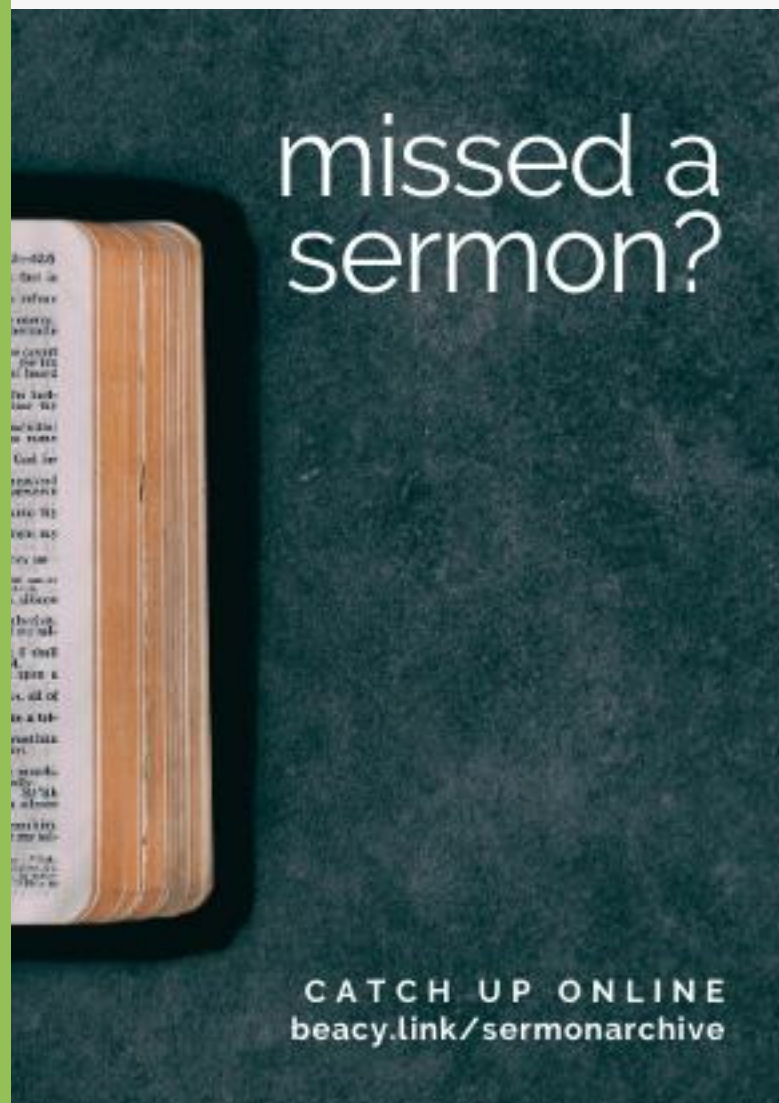
Make and Mingle returns for 2026 on Wednesday 4th February at 10am. You are welcome to come along for a cuppa and chat or to help out the team.

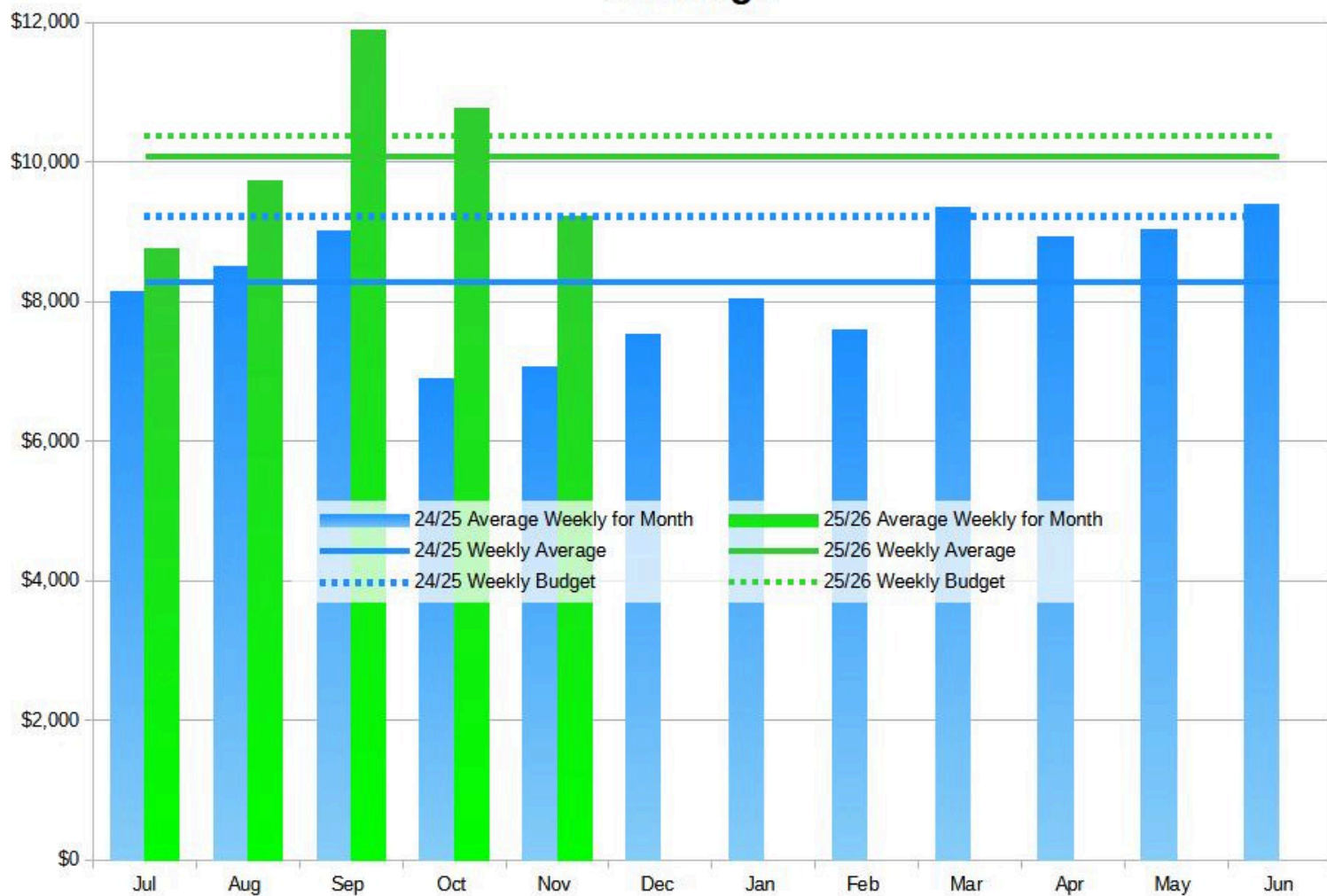
