"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven."

Over the course of July, Beaconsfield Baptist Church will be spending the best part of 4 hours over 4 weeks and 8 services - roughly 30 minutes at a time, one verse at a time, Sunday morning and Sunday night, exploring Ecclesiastes 3:1-8, a most insightful passage of Scripture. Everything means exactly that - everything. There is a time for those things we call good, and a time for those things

we call bad. Circumstances we have no control over and even dread - the writer of Ecclesiastes gives to us a perspective that is both challenging but also wonderfully freeing. In what sense is it freeing? It's freeing in the sense that every circumstance and every moment of every day is under the watchful guiding hand of the God who loves us. That means that chaos doesn't have a free hand to do what it wants. God will always ensure that those He loves, those who place their trust and their hope in Him will not be destroyed. We may not know the reasons why things happen, but we can know who keeps the chaos at bay. And we can most certainly know, that nothing can snatch us out of His powerful and loving hands.

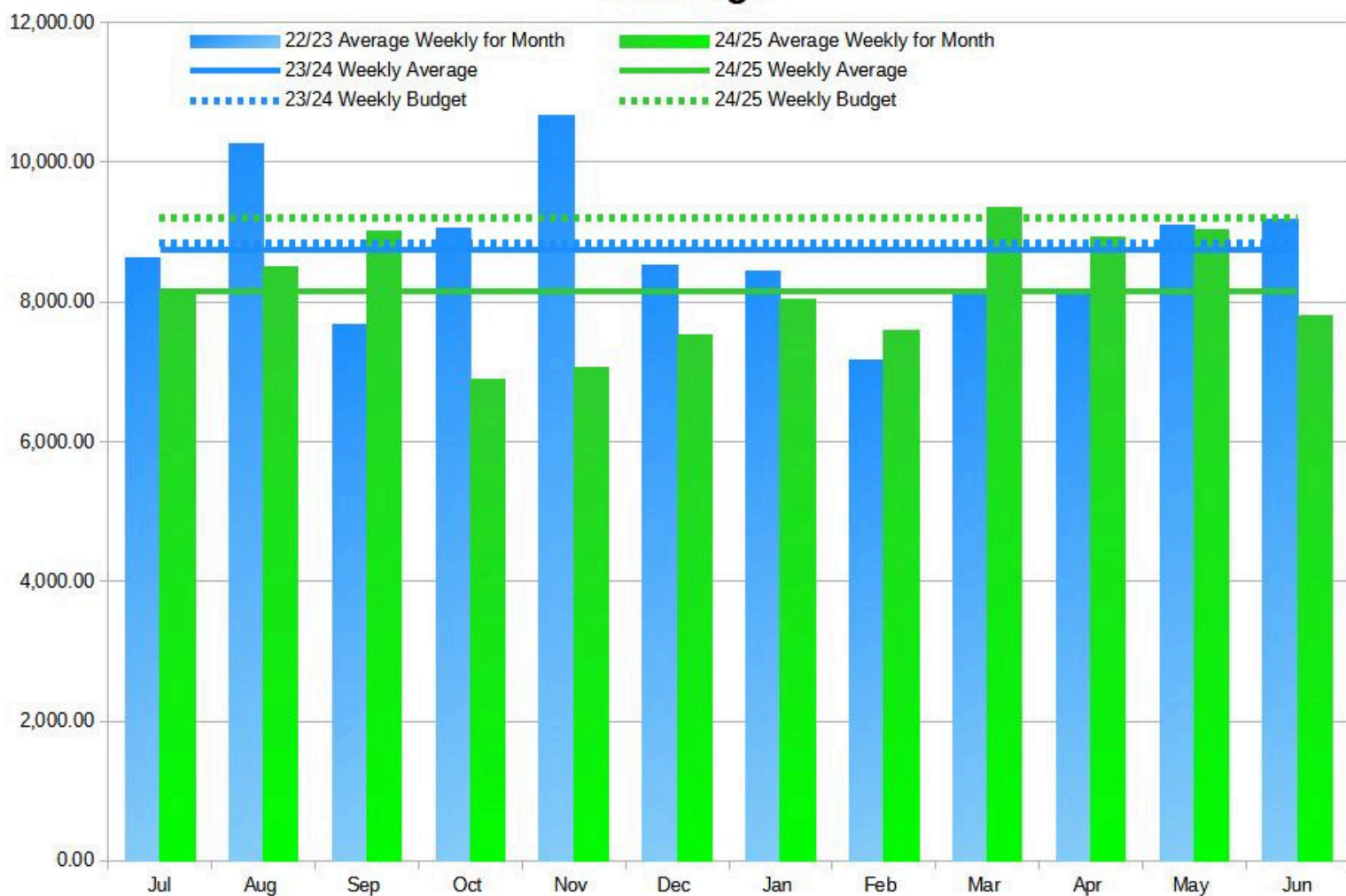
