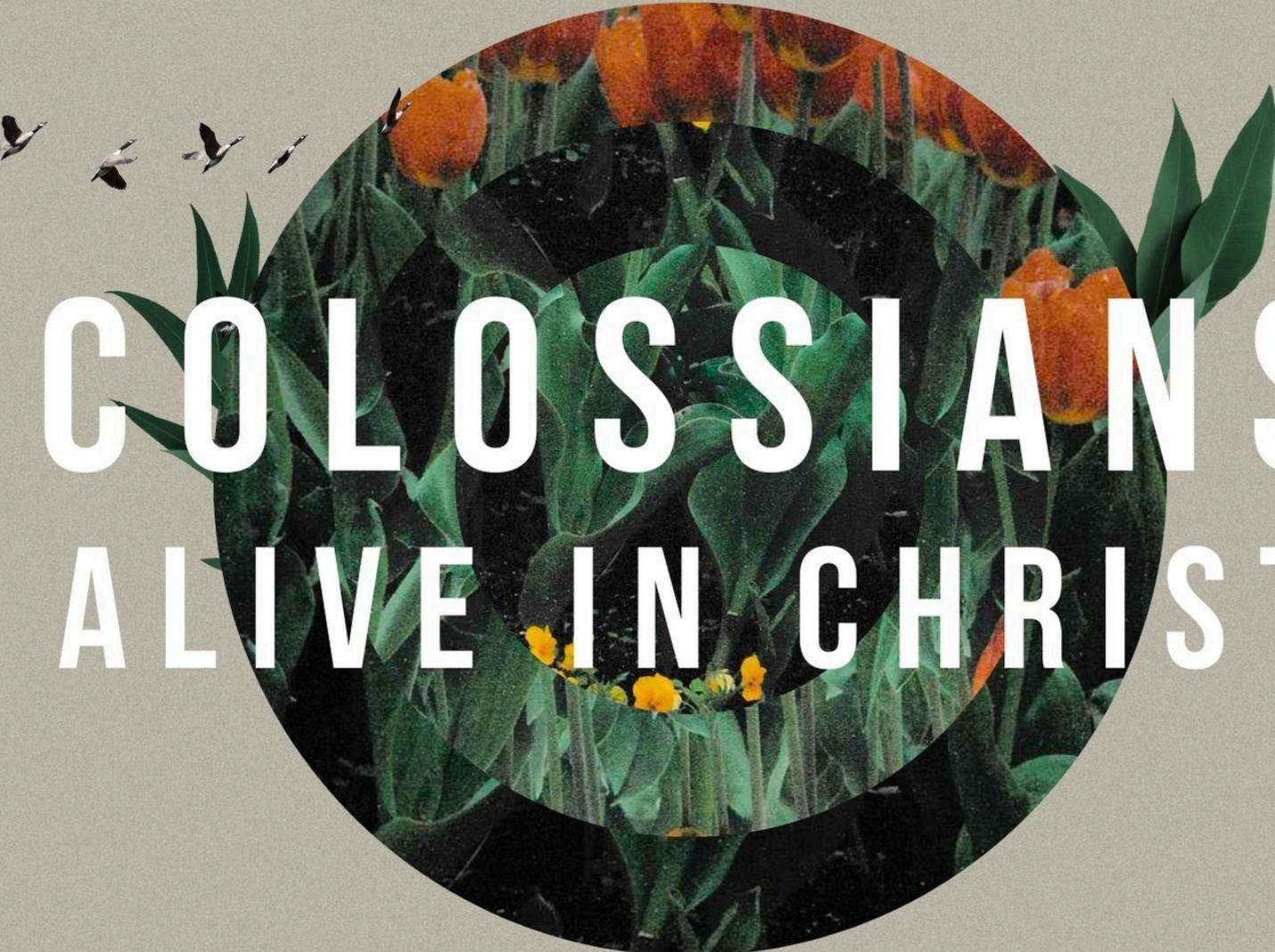

Th program is for a bonfire and bush walk (depending on the weather)

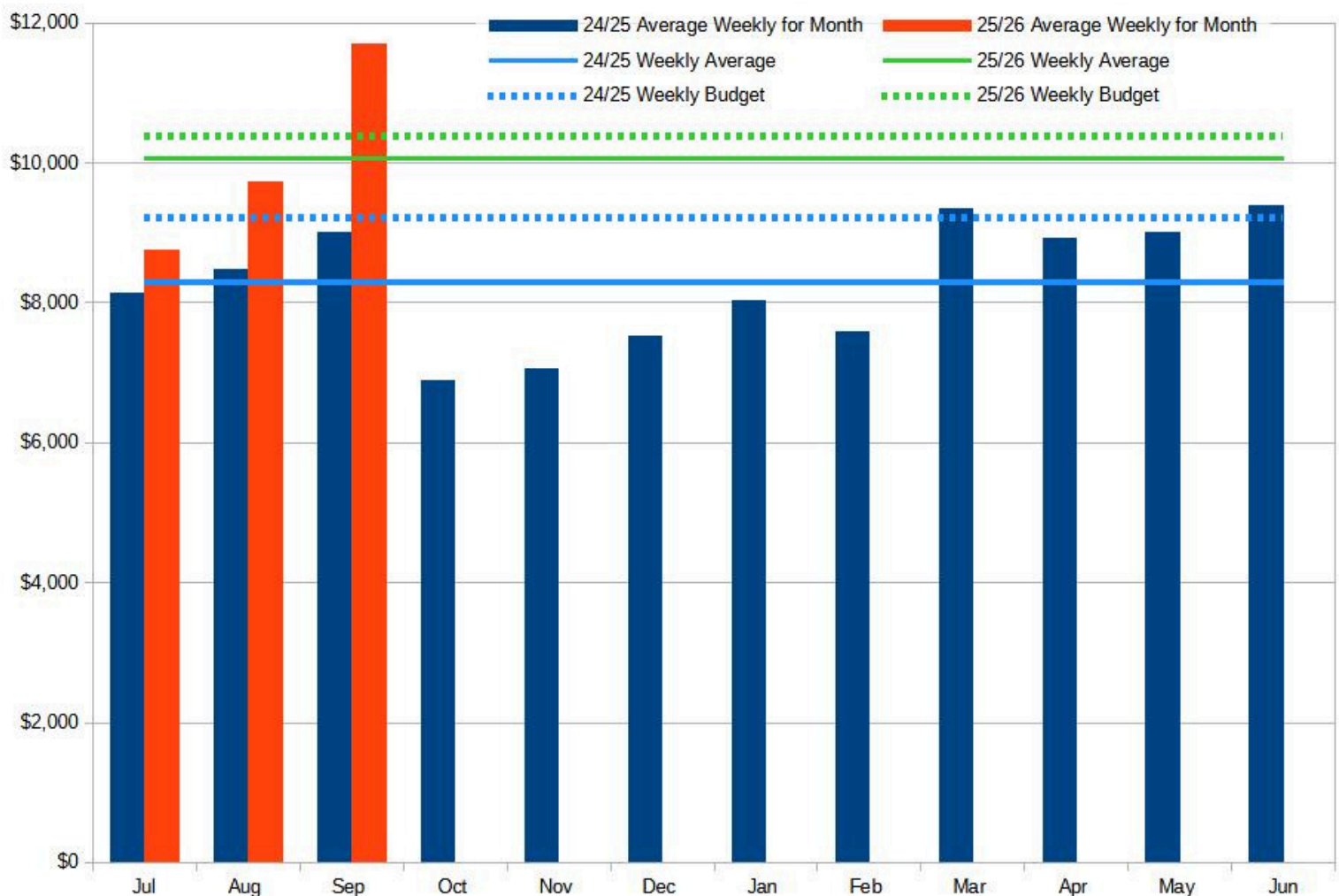

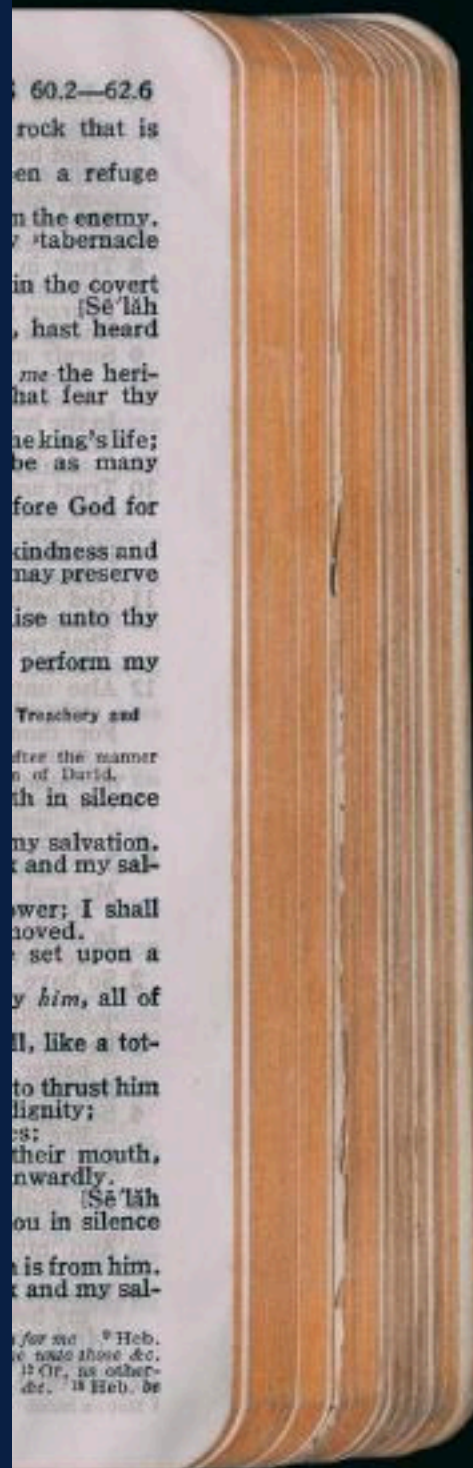


SSHH! LIBRARY NEWS
