If I had to glean just three points as I've walked alongside Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph over the past two years, what would they be? Let me see. I guess the really big take away would be that when God gives His Word, when He makes a promise, He keeps it. He promised to be with Abraham and His descendants through thick and thin, through good and bad. That's exactly what He does. When God makes a promise He keeps it.

The second take away, for me anyway, is how unlikely God's choices are. He chooses people like Jacob. A scoundrel in anyone's language. He chooses people like Reuben and Judah. If their father Jacob was a scoundrel what were they? And yet, having chosen them, He then proceeds to change them. He moulds them into the kind of men that reflect His character. That brings me to my third take away - God's amazing grace. How true is that. In Christ, God chooses the most unlikely candidates, He promises to be their God, and then He makes them into men and women who live for His glory. If you had to glean just three points, what would they be?

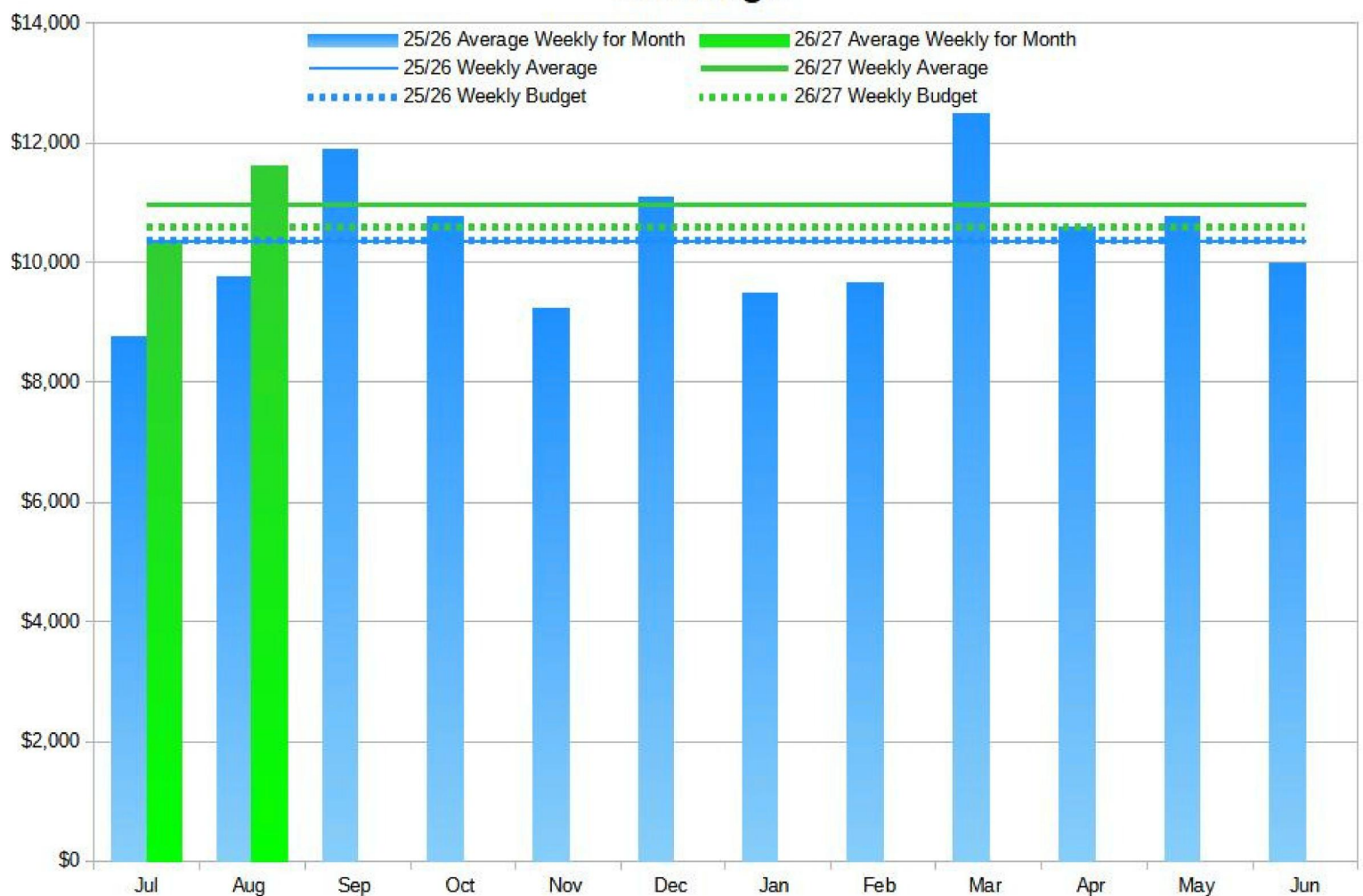
